



## TERMS & CONDITIONS

# Woodside Oboe Scholarship

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### OBJECT

WA Youth Music aims to encourage young musicians to learn the oboe. Successful scholarship recipients will receive either a whole scholarship of up to \$1000, or a half scholarship of up to \$500 towards lessons with a professional teacher. Recipients will have the use of a quality WA Youth Music oboe if available. In addition, WA Youth Music can advise applicants on finding a suitable teacher, if required.

### ELIGIBILITY

String, woodwind and brass players aged around 10 - 13 years are encouraged to apply, but this should not deter beginners or others from applying. Applicants should have reached at least Grade 4 AMEB on a previous instrument and not have learned the oboe.

### CONDITIONS

Scholarship monies are paid at the end of each term. Scholarship holders will need to submit an account from their teacher to the WA Youth Music office at the conclusion of each term to generate payment.

A yearly hire fee of \$75 is charged to cover insurance on the instrument.

All scholarships are subject to WA Youth Music 2011 funding levels.

### APPLYING

Applicants must fill in the attached application form and submit it to the WA Youth Music office by **20 October 2010**.

Copies of relevant documents confirming musical achievements are desirable but not essential, and should be submitted along with the application form.

### AUDITIONING

Applicants may be auditioned during the regular WA Youth Music auditions to be held at the WA Academy of Performing Arts on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2010. They will be asked to perform on their current instrument and undergo an appraisal for the oboe.

### AWARDING

Successful applicants will be notified within one week following auditions.
